Tracy is Vice Chairperson of the East Wavertree and Childwall Tennis Club. She Works as All Stars Coordinator at David Lloyd Knowsley.

Tracy has been designated as a Welfare Officer through the Lawn Tennis Association (LTA). She has been trained in Safeguarding by the LTA and has been the subject of an Enhanced Police Check through the Disclosure Barring Service (DBS.)

The East Wavertree and Childwall Community Association has adopted policies on Safeguarding and Diversity and Inclusion. These policies are displayed in The Association's three buildings, namely the Tennis Club-house, the Community Hall and the Bowls Pavilion.
