

Community Membership Guidance:

- A fee of £20 per annum is payable, running from April to March (can be pro – rated by ¼ 's for memberships starting within the year)
- New Member must be nominated by a full member who has been a member of one of the constituent sections for a minimum 2 years.
- Nominating member must confirm that the potential member is aware of the rules of the appropriate section, and that they are willing to abide by them.
- Nominating member is responsible for the new members' conduct for the first year of membership
- Renewals do not require nomination
- Applications must be made through the appropriate constituent section application process
- Constituent Section Committees are responsible for the community members affiliated to their section
- Community members can bring guests onto the premises (including children) but this is to be managed by the relevant section to ensure that this privilege is not abused

Community Members:

- Must be over 18
- Are required to follow the rules determined by the relevant section to which they are affiliated
- Cannot nominate additional community members

Community Membership enables:

- Use of the licensed clubhouse facilities
- Apply to the EWLTC Management Committee to use the licensed clubhouse facilities for private functions after holding satisfactory community membership for a period of at least 6 months.
- Attendance at social functions/fundraisers (may have additional ticket requirements/fees)
- Attendance at relevant Section or Association Annual General Meeting (AGM)/Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM)

Community Membership does not enable:

- Use of the bowling green or tennis courts
- The provision of a key to any premises/buildings
- A vote at any AGM/EGM
